[1] Tracie K. Bobb lodged a complaint (the "Complaint") pursuant to section 240 of the *Canada Labour Code*, Part III alleging that Cowessess First Nation ("CFN") unjustly dismissed her from her employment on April 1, 2011.

[2] CFN takes issue with the Complaint.

[3] The Minister of Labour (Canada) appointed me to hear and determine the Complaint.

[4] This matter was scheduled for hearing on November 28 and 29, 2016, in Regina, Saskatchewan. On August 29, 2016, I ordered the parties to disclose to each other—on or before the close of business on October 17, 2016—all information and documents needed to hear the complaint.

[5] At the request of Counsel for CFN, I convened a conference call on this date. The parties reported CFN had disclosed all ordered information and documents, but Bobb had not done likewise. Counsel for CFN asked for an order directing Bobb to disclose to CFN—on or before the close of business on December 16, 2016—copies of her income tax returns and notices of assessment for the 2010, 2011 and 2012 taxation years, along with any other documents she may be relying on in relation to her complaint. I find the request appropriate and so order same.

[6] The parties consented to rescheduling the hearing of this matter for January 26 and 27, 2017, in Regina, Saskatchewan. I so order same.
