[1] Kelly A. Mills-Seib lodged a complaint (the "Complaint") pursuant to section 240 of the *Canada Labour Code*, Part III alleging that Yellow Quill First Nation ("YQFN") unjustly dismissed her from her employment on October 8, 2015.

[2] YQFN takes issue with the Complaint.

[3] The Minister of Labour (Canada) appointed me to hear and determine the Complaint.


[4] I convened a conference call to schedule a hearing of this matter and address any preliminary issues raised by the parties.

[5] The parties consented to scheduling the hearing of this matter for January 30 and 31 and February 1, 2017—commencing at 10:00 a.m. each day—in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, at my Arbitration Chambers. I so order same.

[6] The parties asked for an order for disclosure from each to the other of all information and documents needed to hear the complaint. They agreed to an exchange of same on or before the close of business on November 1, 2016. I so order same.

[7] The parties asked that I schedule another conference call to hear representations from the parties concerning the suitability of the scheduled hearing dates and address any further preliminary issues. They consented to scheduling same for 9:00 a.m. on November 1, 2016. I so order same.
